Recommendation: Approve the purchase of two 26KW portable emergency generators from Power Pro Tech Services in the amount of \$28,590

The City maintains approximately 120 wastewater lift stations dispersed across the island. During lengthy power outages, these stations are kept pumped down with portable generators in order to prevent wastewater from spilling onto the ground. The City's seven portable generators are currently moved from station to station, tying up manpower during this very busy time. The plan is to purchase sufficient portable generators to minimize the time expended moving generators from station to station.

On December 4, 2007 an advertisement was placed in the Fort Myers News-Press for the purchase of two portable emergency generators. In response to the ad, 14 bids were submitted and read aloud on January 3, 2008 in the presence Dave Harding and Matt Fannon both from the City.

As per the attached Bid Tabulation, Power Pro Tech Services submitted the low bid for two generators in the amount of \$28,590.

Staff recommends that Council approve the purchase of two 26KW portable emergency generators from Power Pro Tech Services in the amount of \$28,590. There is \$32,000 in the Utility Division capital improvement fund (Fund 451) to purchase these generators.
