RE: Replacement Fuel Canopy at Public Works

Recommendation: Approve Coral Sands Construction & Gould Contracting to construct the replacement fuel canopy at the Public Works Complex for \$42,165, as a joint venture

The fuel depot located at the City's Public Works Complex supplies all City and Sanibel Fire Control District vehicles with both gasoline and diesel fuel. The existing wood/aluminum canopy at the depot, which was relocated from City Hall, is over 20 years old and is in poor condition. It is proposed to replace the existing canopy with a new, all metal, commercial-type canopy, which would:

- meet the current hurricane codes
- allow users a dry area when fueling during inclement weather
- protect the fuel system electronics from the elements

Three bids were received in response to an October 24, 2007 Advertisement for Bids to construct a replacement fuel canopy. The bids were opened and read aloud on December 6, 2007 at 2:00PM in the presence of Mike Rubinski from Universal Structures, David Griggs of Coral Sands Construction and Matt Fannon and Gates Castle from the City. As per the attached bid tabulation, the low bid was submitted by Coral Sands Construction and Gould Contracting as a joint venture in the amount of \$42,165.

Staff recommends that Council approve Coral Sands Construction and Gould Contracting, a joint venture, to construct the fuel canopy at the Public Works Complex in the amount of \$42,165. The FY 08 Capital Improvement budget includes \$40,000 for the work, while the Sanibel Fire Control District has agreed to pay the additional \$2,165.00.
