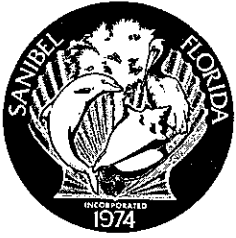
As the Mayor of the City of Sanibel with the authority to bind the City to the terms of the grant application contained herein, I hereby submit this grant application to the Emergency Management Preparedness and Assistance Municipal Competitive Trust Fund in the amount of \$50,000. The City of Sanibel proposes the development of a comprehensive emergency management plan (CEMP) and the establishment of a citizen "Get a Plan" program that is consistent with and furthers the State of Florida, Lee County and Sanibel Emergency Management plans. The City of Sanibel commits to continuing the maintenance and support of this project.

No partners or other entities other than those identified in the application are proposed in coordination with this project. This application is made in fair and good faith, without fraud or collusion with any other entity submitting an application.

Upon notification of funding, the City is prepared to immediately implement the project within the established time frame. As the designated planning coordinator, Major Michael Murray of the Sanibel Police Department will be responsible for full coordination of this grant. The City will provide a cash match of \$50,000 and an in-kind match of \$50,000—representing 67% of the project cost. This is an unconditional commitment of currently available cash funds.
