Completed applications along with proof of Sanibel residency or ownership can be dropped off or mailed to the Sanibel Police Department, Attention: Emergency Management, 800 Dunlop Road, Sanibel, FL 33957, and your hurricane pass will be mailed to you. One of the following proofs of Sanibel residency or ownership is acceptable:

- Florida Driver's License with a Sanibel or Captiva address (No P.O. Box address)
- Business tax receipt
- Tax bill
- Deed
- Rental agreement
- Sanibel Utility Bill (Water, Phone, Cable, Sewer, etc.)
